PROPOSED PROCEDURE CHANGE (PPC) - DETAILED REPORT SECTION

1. Description of change(s) and reasons for change(s)

This PPC proposes changes to the Wholesale Market AMDQ Transfer Procedure.

APA Group proposed a change to the Wholesale Market AMDQ Transfer Procedures. The proposal was to add a new validation to the current Procedure where AEMO would confirm that a market participant held firm contract capacity on an interconnected facility before processing the transfer of Authorised MDQ or nomination of AMDQ Credit Certificates to a System Withdrawal Point (SWP).

AEMO has taken this opportunity to review the Wholesale Market AMDQ Transfer Procedures and has identified that the Wholesale Market AMDQ Transfer Procedures, published in 2012, require further information and has decided to address this at the same time. During this review, synergies in related documents were identified and it was decided to incorporate the existing Wholesale Market AMDQ Auction Procedures and AMDQ Credit Nomination Process into the proposed Wholesale Market AMDQ Procedures.

AEMO have proposed changes to the procedure that ensures the requirements, as described in rule 331(1) and 330(6), are sufficiently covered.

The proposed changes provide clarity and further information on:

- Validation of firm capacity holdings
- Relinquishment of firm capacity
- Requirement of a single priority queue for AMDQ transfers and AMDQ CC nominations
- Requirement for accreditation
- AMDQ Credit Certificate nominations
- AMDQ Auction

This includes:

Changes to the Procedures are grouped under the following 3 categories.

1. Changes to the operation of the Procedures

Changes have been made to:

- Produce a new proposed procedure "Wholesale Market AMDQ Procedure" which incorporates the current,
 - Wholesale Market AMDQ Transfer Procedures
 - Wholesale Market AMDQ Auction Procedures
 - AMDQ Credit nomination process

Key changes include the following clauses:

5.5 (Evidence of firm capacity)

New requirement for AEMO to validate firm capacity rights of a Market Participant wanting to transfer AMDQ to a System Withdrawal Point at an interconnected facility.

5.6 (Expiry or Relinquishment of firm capacity rights)

New section inserted to provide clarity when Market Participants lose firm capacity or when the letter of evidence has expired.

5.1(c) (General Requirements)

New requirement for a market participant to have an application for, or accreditation in place at the time of submitting an application for a transfer or nomination AMDQ.

6.3 (Priority & Delays)

Provide a single priority queue for AMDQ transfer requests and nomination of AMDQ credit certificates.
