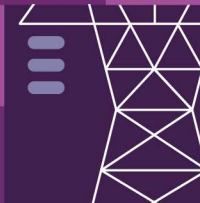


# Reliability and Emergency Reserve Trader (RERT) contracted on Friday 3 February 2023



On 3 February 2023, AEMO entered into seven short notice reserve contracts as set out below.

AEMO entered into these contracts<sup>1</sup> due to a forecast Lack of Reserve 2 (LOR 2) condition in Queensland.

AEMO will publish further details in a quarterly RERT report due in May 2023.
