



Registration Schedule for the Transitional Period

Below are the relevant actions and submission deadlines for registration applications that are submitted between 3 May 2023 and New WEM Commencement Day. The dates may be subject to change and AEMO will endeavour to notify stakeholders as soon as practicable.

AEMO encourages applicants to submit their applications as early as practicable to ensure there is adequate time for AEMO to review the information is complete and accurate for participation in the processes under the new market.

Applications received after the deadlines cannot be guaranteed to be processed in time for Rule Participants to meet their obligations and participate in processes leading up to the new market (e.g. Capacity Credit Allocation and Pre-Dispatch Schedule).

Where an application contains a change to a Facility's existing dispatch data (e.g., minimum/maximum generation, ramp rate) it may require a commissioning test to validate the data. As a result, longer processing times are expected, and submissions earlier than 1 August 2023 are encouraged for Facility data.

Application fees for Facility Registration, Facility Aggregation, Facility Disaggregation, Facility Class Assessment or Reassessment will not apply to existing registered Facilities during the transitional period.
