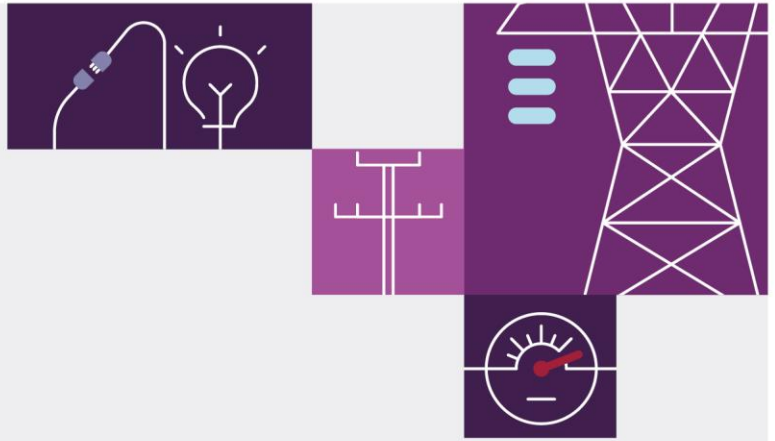

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1 Introduction

1.1 Overview

These are the release notes for the WEM Dispatch Engine 3.0.2 release.
The changes introduced in this release are described in the sections below.

1.2 Terms and abbreviations

The terms and abbreviations used in this document are outlined in Table 1.

2 FCESS Clearing Price Ceiling Defined by Parameters [WEMDE-11]

To facilitate proposed changes to the FCESS Clearing Price Ceiling, AEMO have modified the WEM Dispatch Engine code to use a defined fixed valued as a parameter rather than the calculation as defined within the WEM Rules.

Five new parameters will be included in all WEM Dispatch Engine case files and applied as the FCESS Clearing Price Ceiling:

- RegulationRaiseClearingPriceCeiling
- RegulationLowerClearingPriceCeiling
- ContingencyRaiseClearingPriceCeiling
- ContingencyLowerClearingPriceCeiling
- RocofClearingPriceCeiling

3 Missing Ramp Rate Constraints during Fast Start Operation [WEMDE-15]

In testing of the Fast Start Operation in WEMDE, AEMO were notified by a Market Participant that Ramp Rate Constraints were not applied once the Facility was operating in mode 5. Mode 5 effectively represents the Facility's operation if it remains "in-merit" after the completion of the Fast Start Inflexibility Profile.

AEMO will be proposing updates to Step 1 of the Dispatch Algorithm Solution Process in WEM Procedure Dispatch Algorithm Formulation to align with this change.
