Australia Pacific LNG Pty Ltd (APLNG) welcomes the opportunity to contribute to the consultation process on the *Amendments to GSOO Procedures* Impact and Implementation Report (IIR).

APLNG is an incorporated company and one of the largest producers of natural gas in eastern Australia, delivering a reliable energy source to customers in Australia and Asia. We are the largest net contributor of gas supply to Australia's domestic east coast gas market, providing over 2,100 PJ of gas into the domestic market since the project was sanctioned.

Response to IIR on GSOO Procedure change for hydrogen

APLNG reviewed AEMO's IIR and revised proposed amendments to the GSOO Procedures, with particular regard to the topics we previously submitted on:

- the obligation on AEMO to inform and request feedback on changes to survey templates and the GSOO timeline
- the definition of material change in the context of the GSOO Procedures, and the obligation on reporting entities to update their GSOO survey responses for material change.

APLNG acknowledges that AEMO has reflected stakeholder feedback, including that from APLNG, in the revised proposed amendments to the GSOO Procedures. APLNG considers AEMO's revised amendments address our concerns and will improve the operation of the GSOO Procedures. APLNG has no further comment on the IIR.
