Executive Summary

The publication of this final report (**Final Report**) concludes the process conducted by AEMO (**Consolidation Process**) in respect of the proposal (**Consolidation Proposal**) to consolidate relevant versions of the Retail Electricity Market Procedures (**Consolidating Procedures**) which have a shared effective date of 30 May 2023.

The Consolidating Procedures are:

- MSATS Procedures: CATS Procedure Principles and Obligations.
- MSATS Procedures: Procedure for the Management of WIGS NMIs.
- Standing Data for MSATS document.

The Consolidation Proposal does not involve any substantive amendments to the Consolidating Procedures. The previous changes to the Consolidating Procedures were consulted on in 2022 and 2023, in accordance with NER 8.9. Accordingly, for the purposes of NER 8.9.4, the Consolidation Process is minor and administrative in nature.

AEMO received two submissions in response to the May 2023 Consolidation Process Proposal Paper (**Proposal Paper**). These submissions were supportive of the Consolidation Proposal and provided suggestions for future changes to the Consolidating Procedures.

AEMO's final determination is to amend the Consolidating Procedures in the form published with this Final Report.

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1. Process

AEMO is undertaking the Consolidation Process in accordance with the following indicative timeline.

2. Background

2.1 NER requirements

AEMO is responsible for the establishment and maintenance of metering procedures specified in Chapter 7 except for procedures established and maintained under rule 7.17.

The procedures authorised by AEMO under NER Chapter 7 must be established and maintained by AEMO in accordance with the NER, including NER 7.16.2.

2.2 Context

AEMO has conducted the Consolidation Process to consolidate the Changed Procedures into the Consolidating Procedures to ensure:

- the change to the effective date of the MSATS “Last Consumer Change Date” field, from 30 May 2023 to 1 November 2023, pursuant to the Consumer Data Right (CDR) MSATS Minor Amendment Proposal; and
- the information in the Standing Data for MSATS document is accurate and up-to-date.

3. Summary of Material Issues

No material issues were raised by the Consulted Persons.

Based on feedback received, the following amendments have been made to the consolidated procedures:

- Minor error in *MSATS Procedures: Procedure for the Management of Wholesale, Interconnector, Generator and Sample (WIGS) NMIS* – section 7.2.4 LNSP Requirements (page 50) CR 5050/5051 incorrectly refers to “House Number To” as “House Number To 3”.
- Change-marked versions of the consolidated procedures to reflect marked changes from each consolidated procedure.
- Addition of CT Ratio (Available) 100/150:1 and 500/2000/3000:1 as requested from PLUE ES.

4. Final Determination

Having considered the matters raised in submissions, AEMO’s final determination is to consolidate the Consolidating Procedures in the form published with this Final Report.
