Executive Summary

The publication of this final report (**Final Report**) concludes the process conducted by AEMO (**Consolidation Process**) in respect of the proposal (**Consolidation Proposal**) to consolidate relevant versions of the Retail Electricity Market Procedures (**Consolidating Procedures**) which have a shared effective date of 01 November 2023.

The Consolidating Procedures are:

- MSATS Procedures: CATS Procedure Principles and Obligations.
- MSATS Procedures: Procedure for the Management of WIGS NMIs.
- Standing Data for MSATS document.

The Consolidation Proposal does not involve any substantive amendments to the Consolidating Procedures. AEMO consulted on the amendments to the Consolidating Procedures in 2023. Accordingly, for the purposes of NER 8.9.4, the Consolidation Process is minor and administrative in nature.

AEMO received two submissions in response to the November 2023 Consolidation Process Amendment Paper (**Amendment Paper**). These submissions were supportive of the Consolidation Proposal.

AEMO's final determination is to amend the Consolidating Procedures in the form published with this Final Report.

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1. Process

AEMO has undertaken the Consolidation Process in accordance with the following timeline.

2. Background

2.1 NER requirements

AEMO is responsible for the establishment and maintenance of metering procedures specified in Chapter 7 except for procedures established and maintained under rule 7.17.

The procedures authorised by AEMO under NER Chapter 7 must be established and maintained by AEMO in accordance with the NER, including NER 7.16.2.

2.2 Context

AEMO has conducted the Consolidation Process to reflect the following:

- The addition of a “Last Consumer Change Date” field into MSATS to support Consumer Data Right (CDR).
- The referencing of jurisdictional regulation in respect of the Customer Threshold Codes.
- The ICF 074 change to allow the MDP to receive the Cancelled and Rejected notifications for CR 5050 and CR 5051.
- The changes to allow the LNSP to receive the Rejected notification for CR 5050 and CR 5051.
- The ICF 075 change to require the current FRMP to update the Last Consumer Change Date field.
- The amendments to the Test Result field examples in the Standing Data for MSATS document and the replacement of the values list with the relevant website link.
